WELCOME & THANK YOU FOR TAKING PART AT THE FIRST CYCAD AUCTION IN ZIMBABWE. IN SOUTH AFRICA THEY HOLD A NUMBER OF AUCTIONS EVERY YEAR.

- 1. Every buyer needs a Buyer's Card. The deposit is \$50-00. The deposit will be credited to your account. If no purchases are made, the deposit will be refunded in full.
- All plants are sold "Voetstoets" meaning you buy the plant as you see it. There will be no returns or refunds.
- 3. All cycads fall under the International CITES Convention and they cannot be exported without a permit from National Parks. Please keep your receipt of payment for proof of legally acquired plants.
- 4. Each plant has a number, a Seller's letter code, plus the species name and size. Some plants may have a reserve price if a bid is lower than the reserve price, it is up to the seller if the bid is acceptable. If not accepted, the plant will be withdrawn from the sale.
- 5. The successful bidder may remove the plant only after the auction is finished and the plant has been paid for in full in cash or by preapproved agreement. A 10% commission of the selling price goes to the Aloe, Cactus & Succulent Society and that commission is payable by the seller, not the buyer.

Please arrange mode of payment with the Cashier, the Chairman or the Auctioneer.

- 7. There are instructions available with regards to planting and looking after the cycads.
